The one-way system will remain in place in the mornings. You can drop your child off at the relevant gate at any time between 8.45 and 8.55 am and they will make their way to their classroom; staff will be on hand to show your child where they need to go as well as members of the Senior Leadership Team. Please note that you are able to come through the green gate at the end of the day. Once you have collected your child, it is important that you leave the school site promptly; the gates will be closed and locked at 3.30 pm.

We will be continuing with children wearing PE Kit into school on the relevant day. Where possible, children will also be doing Forest School on the same day so will need suitable clothing for this to put over the top of their PE kit, and a change of shoes. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that school PE kit consists of black shorts or tracksuit bottoms, white t-shirt and plimsolls/trainers; children are expected to wear their school jumper with their PE kit rather than a tracksuit top. On the days that children do not have PE and Forest School, full school uniform is required. For further details, please view the school website. School shoes should be plain black and children should not wear boots or trainers as part of their school uniform. Bows and other hair accessories are not part of school uniform.

Breakfast and After-School Club will start again on the first day of term. Bookings can be made via West Hill Life Ltd; details of which can be found on the website.

I hope you enjoy the remainder of the summer break and we look forward to welcoming all families back to school for the next academic year.
